

## OFFICE BEARERS

Lennox Street end of balcony dangerous to use in present state and advisable to cut off from use Ann Street end of balcony.

1966/7 Balfour Thomson succeeded Norman AM Macdonald as Secretary (August). Repairs carried out and Pavilion repainted by Members. ID Black died after 15 years as Treasurer and Balfour Thomson added office of Treasurer to Secretary. Sub. = £5. Students = £4. Ladies 2nd in Division I. Men relegated to Division II. 3 Ladies in East Team - Chloe Scott, Jennifer Elder and Alice Simpson.

1969 First reference to proposed rebuilding of Pavilion - Robin Gray (Architect), a Club member, was asked to produce specimen plans to include one Squash Court Development Committee set up with David Filsell as Secretary. Sub. = £6. Students = £5. Ladies team - Winners of East League and Runners-up in Scottish Cup (beaten 5-4 in Final by Newlands). Membership highest ever at 158 full members.

1971 Decision to construct a new Clubhouse incorporating two Squash courts with Robin Gray as Architect. "Develop or Die" was the title of the Appeal Brochure. RC Ewart became President. Approach to Scottish Sports Council in October when total cost was estimated at £24,000.

1972 Formal application to Sports Council for a Grant.

1973 Offer of Grant of £10,700 from Sports Council towards cost of scheme then estimated at £26,900. Much delay due to initial refusal of Planning Permission and objections from local residents. Planning permission granted on appeal. Dean of Guild Court approval granted in May. Dean Lawn Tennis (Enterprises) Limited formed to carry out work using voluntary Club labour and sub-contractors. Fund-raising activities continued - Jumble Sales, Sales of Work, Prize Draws etc. Temporary accommodation on garden ground at Dean Park Crescent end due to demolition of old Clubhouse. 130 senior, 27 student and 32 junior members.

1974 RC Ewart elected to stay on extra year as President while building works proceeded. By October estimated additional £17,000 required to complete the building.

1975 Application to Scottish Sports Council for additional Grant aid. Council approved an additional special grant of £9,000 after inspection of building. Edinburgh Corporation also approached for a Public Works loan and offer of loan of £12,000 made.

1976 Work on building finally nearing completion. Squash Committee formed by Michael Sturrock. Hugh McTurk succeeded Bobby Ewart as President.

1977 New Clubhouse and Squash Courts came into use - formally opened by Peter Heatly, Chairman of Scottish Sports Council on 23rd September. Loan of £10,000 received from Edinburgh Corporation. Final Cost was £58,000. Fund-raising activities continued under David Filsell's Committee. Club name changed to Dean Lawn Tennis and Squash Club.

1981 Quotation for all-weather court and making small practice area approved at cost of £10,872.

1984 Hugh McTurk appointed President for second term to cover Club's Centenary year. Veterans' Mixed Doubles Silver Salver presented by Mrs Isobel Rainnie.
