

DEAN T&SC: COVID 19 – SQUASH / CLUBHOUSE RISK ASSESSMENT

14th Sep 2021

A risk assessment was conducted at the club by Jerry Williams, Liz Falconer and Michael Clarkson on 31st August 2020 prior to opening for solo / household squash

Risk assessment was done again on 17th July 2021 by Jerry Williams and Michael Clarkson and updated accordingly prior to opening for full squash on 19th July 2021.

Updated on 14th Sep following full reopening of clubhouse.

Key areas identified as risk for Covid-19 transmission through contaminated objects or surface and agreed action:

Risk	Action / Mitigant
Common surfaces that will be touched by members: Door from court 1 viewing balcony into corridor Door from corridor into court 2 viewing area Door to clubroom Doors into both squash courts Light switches for both squash courts Equipment in club room (table tennis, fusbball, gym equipment) Changing room benches	Door from court 1 viewing balcony into corridor, door from corridor into court 2 viewing area and club room door will all be kept open Disinfectant spray and wipes provided next to court doors and light switches and members advised to wipe surface after touching. Sign will be placed next to those areas Disinfectant spray and wipes provided in club room and members asked to wipe down after use. Signs placed next to areas Disinfectant spray and wipes provided in changing rooms and members asked to wipe down after use. Signs placed next to areas Increase cleaning by contractor from once per week to twice per week
Toilet area	Disinfectant spray is provided in both the male and female toilets to be applied to the toilet seat and flush after use Handwashing facilities are available in both changing rooms and toilets

Risk of contamination on other surfaces	<p>Hand sanitiser provided at entrance and throughout club (including entrance to club room) and members advised to use before and after use Sign will be placed next to those areas</p> <p>Close changing rooms and shower area (apart from toilet) and club-room to minimise risk Sign will be placed next to those areas</p>
Ventilation	<p>Corridor doors and club room door kept open at all times</p> <p>Members asked to open fire exit when using club room.</p> <p>Extractor fans in changing rooms</p>

Key areas identified as risk for Covid-19 transmission through close contact:

Risk	Action
Close contact due to players arriving / leaving at the same time	<p>Members required to book a squash court (and club) in order to play/use</p> <p>Squash court 1 and 2 booking times are already staggered to minimise numbers entering/exiting club at same time</p>
Any other contact with members within clubhouse	Face masks required before/after play

We have a telephone number for the vast majority of our members. We have asked members to check and update their number (through either the membermojo or booking website) in the comms emailed and printed off in the clubhouse walls. If we are asked by public health officers to provide the names, numbers, data/time of visit of members, as part of Test & Protect, we will retrieve the info from the booking website / membermojo

All guidance is detailed in a document that will be emailed to members and printed and placed in various parts of the clubhouse. Specific signs will also be placed in clubhouse where indicated above.

The Scottish Squash guidance has been read and adhered to
