

Using the squash and tennis facilities

Squash courts

Accessing the squash courts is via the door immediately ahead as you enter the clubhouse. Turn left, and immediately left again down the stairs to court 1. Switch the court lights on by a single press of the white circular button. Press and hold for 5 seconds to switch the lights off when leaving the court.



To access court 2, continue down the sloping corridor instead of down to the left, then through the door at the end. Press the red button to switch the court lights on, and the black button to switch them off.



Tennis Court Lights

The light switches are contained within a waterproof box located at the foot of the steps down from the Lennox Street path.

To access the switches you need to use the panel key which is attached to the lower column supporting the handrail by the steps.



Each court has separate on (green) and off (red) single press switches – court 1 at the top, court 4 at the bottom. Court 1 is the court nearest the clubhouse.



You should only switch on the lights for the court you are about to use and you must turn the lights off at the end of your game unless other members present are waiting to use your court.

IMPORTANT: The door to the box must be closed and locked immediately after you have opened it to switch lights on or off. This is essential to prevent rain water getting into the box. You will need to push the door closed in order to lock it fully.

The lights will automatically switch off at 10 pm (9pm during winter)
