Major N. G. Holmes. He and Captain Carruthers lost few matches during the short time they played together in the team. In D. H. Watt and F. S. Paterson the club had two of the strongest young players in the East of Scotland. One season with the foregoing four to represent them in every match would almost certainly have ensured the league championship, and probably the Scottish Cup too. A. W. Banks has also played for the club, and R. G. Manson, W. R. Rainnie, and A. K. Watson have helped to keep the club in the front rank of Edinburgh tennis.

With the existing keenness among the many promising young players now members of the club, the Dean officials and well-wishers may well face the future with great confidence.
