

two Members. The admission will be by Ballot of the Members, and one black ball in seven will exclude. A Ballot will be held on the first and third Saturday of each month for the admission of Members, and names must be sent in to the Secretary a week before.

IV.

The General Concerns of the Club shall be managed by the Guarantors, who have power to appoint Sub-Committees, or to make such general regulations, and to appoint Sub-Officers, as may be necessary for the well-being of the Club.

V.

A Meeting of Guarantors will be held annually in March, at which the Secretary will submit his Accounts and Report for the previous year.

VI.

The ground shall be under the exclusive management of the Guarantors, and without consent of two-thirds of the same no material alteration may be made thereon. As the ground may be taken by the Proprietors on one month's notice for the purpose of building, and the Club in that event be broken up, the Members shall take that risk.

VII.

Each Member will be furnished with a copy of the Rules, and shall be bound thereby.

VIII.

Any Member acting in contravention of the Rules, or being obnoxious to other Members, and persisting therein after being warned, shall be liable to be expelled by a vote of the majority of the Guarantors.

IX.

The foregoing Rules shall be the fundamental Rules of the Club, and shall not be altered except at a General Meeting of the Guarantors. Notice of any alteration proposed must be given at least fourteen days before the Meeting at which it is to be proposed.

RULES AS TO PLAY, Etc.

X.

No set of Players shall use the Courts for longer than two sets (of eleven games) at a time, in the event of any other Members wishing to play. X

XI.

Any Member may bring a friend to the Courts occasionally, but such friend can only play if the Courts are not fully occupied.

XII.

Each set of Players shall be responsible for the number of Balls they use in playing, and shall make good those lost by them. X

XIII.

No dogs shall be admitted to the ground.
